**ORDINANCE NO 6
OF THE RECTOR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW**

of 13 January 2017

**on subjects preparing for the study,
common for all fields of study**

Pursuant to § 29 s. 1 of the Rules of Study at the University of Warsaw (UW Monitor 2015, item 71), it is hereby ordered as follows:

§ 1

1. Study curricula should include 4 hours of classes in the following subjects:
 - 1) occupational health and safety;
 - 2) introduction to intellectual property protection.
2. Each of the subjects referred to in s. 1 shall be allocated 0.5 ECTS credit, which may be included in the pool of 5% of total ECTS credits allocated to general university subjects.
3. Classes in subjects referred to in s.1 shall be completed with an assessment.

§ 2

1. Ordinance no 43 of the Rector of the University of Warsaw of 18 October 2010 on subjects preparing for the study, common for all fields of study, i.e. occupational health and safety and introduction to intellectual property protection (UW Monitor 2010, item 186) shall be hereby cancelled.
2. The ordinance shall come into force on the date of its signing and shall apply starting the 2017/2018 academic year.
